We are the Purdue university chapter of the organization *Asha for Education*, which currently has 67 chapters all over the world.

The mission of Asha is to catalyze socio-economic change in India through the education of underprivileged children.

Asha-Purdue's activities have shown significant growth over the past couple of years. From just one project to start with, Asha Purdue now supports 2 projects in India and have raised \$30580 since 2011. We have disbursed \$24600 to our projects in 2011-2013. We are currently reviewing more projects to fund in the coming years. Our activities include 5k run, cultural events (Tarang, Tamasha), movie screenings, Global food festival and discussions on education related issues (movies, speakers).
